

## **REOPENING KIDS MINISTRY**

Tips for preparing to open kids ministry in your church.

## **POLICY & PROCEDURES**

- Disinfect classrooms before & after each service.
- Screening and evaluating children prior to entering
  - Kids need to be fever free, without a fever reducer, for 24 hours before attending class.
  - 2. Kids may not attend class if they have had diarrhea or vomiting in the last 24 hours.
  - 3. Kids may not attend class with any other symptoms such as pink-eye, coughing, runny nose, wheezing, etc.
- Surfaces and objects that are frequently touched should be cleaned and sanitized regularly, even those that are not usually cleaned daily (toys, games, etc.)
- Toys that children have placed in their mouths must be removed from the play area until sanitized.
- Workers/volunteers should handle check in, rather than allowing parents to do so on iPads or computers.
- Clean visibly dirty surfaces with soap and water prior to disinfecting.
- Hand sanitizer must be in each room, as well as extra gloves & masks just in case.
- Designate a chair/seat for each child as they come in they must remain using that same seat for all of class.

## TIPS

- Reach out to parents see how comfortable they are with bringing their kids back to kids church.
- · Communicate directly with parents about your plan.
- Infants/toddlers stay with parents.

- Only 1 parent dropping of kids.
- Keep socially distanced even in classrooms chairs/seats 6 ft apart.
- Limit the amount of people in the kids area.
- Hallway monitor to disinfect bathrooms (toilet & sink) after each use.
- Have a plan for check in and check out to keep social distancing measures.
- · Repeat your policies in multiple different ways.
- Post signage in your kids area with wellness policy, plans/policy, snack policy, when closed for sanitizing, traffic patterns, cleaning checklist.
- No plush toys or books.
- No snacks to keep kids from touching their face.
- Divide toys and switch out between services.
- Keep a cleaning checklist for every room (date & time).
- Prepare bags of craft supplies ahead of time with each kids name on them with a sticker (for example scissors, crayons, glue stick, etc)
- · Keep providing ministry for your kids online.

## **VOLUNTEER TIPS**

- Recruit additional volunteers for rooms, check in and hall monitors.
- Re-envision your volunteers.
- Re-up with your volunteers individually.
- Relay new policies/procedures/ expectations.
